Sample document

This PDF ships with the EziWiki demo content so the document viewer has something to show.

It was embedded from Markdown with a single line:

```
! [[sample.pdf]]
```

Nothing else is needed. The build finds the file under `public/`, emits a link to it, and the viewer is mounted into that link in the browser.



Page two

Scrolling and paging

Pages are drawn as you reach them, not all at once, so a long document costs no more to open than a short one.

The chevrons in the toolbar move a page at a time. The counter follows the scroll either way, so it always says where you are rather than where you last clicked.

The viewer scrolls on its own; reaching the last page leaves you on the last page rather than carrying you off into the rest of the article.



Page three

Zoom, download, full screen

A document opens fitted to the column it was embedded in. That fit is what 100% means here, so it stays fitted when the window is resized or the viewer is thrown full screen.

Past 100% the page overflows and the viewer scrolls sideways to follow it.

The download button hands over the original file, which is also what a reader without JavaScript is given in place of all of this.
